PARISH COUNCIL

At the February meeting plans for Meadow Cottage and Clock House were discussed; concerns were raised by councillors and residents about materials and detail on the proposed gable to Meadow Cottage; it was noted that Clock House is listed, but it was thought the impact would not be significant. Permission has been granted for nos 2&4 High Street.

Ringway, the council highways contractor, has given a figure in excess of £36000 for removal of The Close garages; as this is excessive another site meeting with MKC has been requested.

Proposed cuts to rural bus services was discussed.

The March meeting agreed payments to local organisations that benefit the community.

Plans for stone wall and hay barn at Grange Farm had no objections.

It was reported that MK Public Realm officers are being pursued to get the paths resurfaced as agreed at the agreed price. It is hoped that one of these officers will attend the AGM.

The Alcove lease has finally come back, and after a bit of last minute adjustment was deemed agreeable; it is hoped this will be signed at the AGM.

We have again entered the BKV competition; it is hoped that without a Fete to occupy everyone a real effort can be made to bring the cup back to Weston!

Common sense has prevailed in some budget cuts, and a rural bus service will continue.
